

2008 DISC Scholarship Essay Challenge

Challenge: In a creative way, convey to the appraisers one asset or attribute about yourself that was gained or enhanced through participation in Destination ImagiNation® programs.

Time: Your application, solution and other supporting documents must be received by **January 15, 2008**

The Scene: ‘Creative’, for the purposes of this challenge, is defined as *unique, different, unusual, unexpected, and non-traditional*.

Materials: You may use any materials or methods that can be digitally archived as a document or image. Total file size cannot exceed 10MB.

Scoring: You will receive

A. Points for creativity.

B. Points for relevancy.

C. Points for creative problem solving participation.

D. Points for correct grammar and spelling (you ARE going to college, after all!)

(Please note that if you choose to use words for your “essay”, we ask that you keep to a maximum of 1,000 words..)

The Committee will require an electronic format of whatever you create!

If your entry is a video or has a file size larger than 2 MB, we will require 5 copies on CDs, DVDs or VHS tapes that can be circulated among committee members. Those should be mailed along with any other documents to the address specified below. You may email entries less than 2MB in size. Please contact us if you have any question about this!
